Recent Major Projects

In 2020 and 2021 we purchased 70 grills for the campsites and 2 pedal boats and an electric push lawn mower. In addition to firewood and t-shirt sales we had two fundraisers to pay for all the aviary food for a year and to renovate the 16 picnic tables built by the Civilian Conservation Corp. (CCC) in the 1930's.

In 2014 we saw the need to build an aviary for our wounded hawk and owls. It is currently home to Henson the Red-Tailed Hawk, Petrie the Barn Owl, Chompers the Great Horned Owl, and Bobble the Eastern Screech Owl. In 2023 are waiting for state approval of our design to expand the aviary to hold 6 birds and will also be building an amphitheater between the two aviaries to present Birds of Prey Programs.
